

What airports are you close to?

The closest airport to Boston University is Logan International Airport (BOS), which is about eight miles from campus. From the terminal, follow the signs to Ground Transportation, where you can take a taxi or ride-share to campus or take the Silver Line bus to South Station.

Where to stay?

The primary hotel for the 2019 ARHE/ARS/AAPG Conference will be the Hyatt Regency Cambridge. Located just across the river from Boston University and situated along the scenic Charles River overlooking Boston, Hyatt Regency Cambridge offers luxury accommodations and amenities. The 2019 per person per night rate for the residence hall is set at \$88 for single-occupancy with shared bathroom. This rate includes bed and bath linen and amenities. All rooms contain a single twin-sized mattress. Conference attendees are not allowed overnight guests. Anyone planning to stay in University housing must secure their own room and pay the nightly fee. The reservation site typically closes for reservations 3-5 business days prior to the earliest arrival date or when inventory is full. 10 Buick Street is an apartment-style, air-conditioned residence hall. Each apartment consists of four single-occupancy bedrooms, kitchen, common room, and two bathrooms. Kitchens are not stocked with utensils or other kitchenware.
